NAMES OF SMALL TOPOGRAPHIC OBJECTS IN VICINITY OF MUKHRINO FIELD STATION

Small topographic objects in the vicinity of the station had been named by MFS to increase understanding between visitors. The are 15 logged paths crossing Mukhrino bog made about 10-20 years ago for seismological surveys. They are currently used for walking and off-road transport and are convenient marks to communicate the area of interest.

Three main rivers and one lake were designated in topographic maps: Mukhrina river and Mukhrino lake, Bolshaya Rechka river, Baybalak channel. Other small lakes with peat bottom and 9 streams originating from Mukhrino bog were newly named. We encourage our visitors to use standardized names for communication and description of the working area.
